

U.S Army Junior ROTC exceeds schools' averages in each of these categories:

CATEGORY	SCHOOL	JROTC
Attendance	90.29%	93.54%
Graduation	83%	93.98%
Indiscipline	5.2%	1.7%
Dropout	8%	<1%
GPA	2.72	2.91
