SUBJECT: Delegation of Final Approving Authority for Line of Duty Investigations

1. Reference. AR 600-8-4, Paragraph 1-10b, Line of Duty Policy, Procedures, and Investigations, 4 September 2008.
2. You are hereby delegated final approving authority for Line of Duty investigations, with the exception of those investigations involving the death of a Soldier. A copy of this document must be included in all line of duty cases where delegated authority has been exercised. Investigations found to be "Not in Line of Duty" will be reviewed by the Fort Knox Office of the Staff Judge Advocate.
3. I retain the authority to cancel or withdraw the delegated authority at any time. Upon change of command, the delegation of authority is subject to review, change, or cancellation by the new commander. Delegate authority is automatically canceled upon the retirement, change of duties, or change of position of the individual who has delegate authority. Further delegation of this authority is not authorized.
