



# Cadet News: Uniform Dos and Don'ts

## Berets


**CCR 145-2:** "JROTC Cadets are not authorized to wear similar colors of the following Total Army units: Special Forces (green); Ranger (tan); Airborne (maroon); and other Soldiers (black) berets. The wear of the above berets is reserved exclusively for units of the Total Army."



**JROTC Grey Beret**



**Green:** Special Forces



**Tan:** Army Rangers



**Maroon:** Airborne



**Black:** Active Duty



**Brown:** SFAB



**CCR 145-2:** "Headgear is part of the uniform. Cadets are required to wear the gray beret while outdoors or when carrying air/drill rifles or a saber. The gray beret with a distinctive flash is the only authorized headgear to be worn with the dress uniform"



Drill Teams may only use an exhibition uniform at authorized events per Drill event Standard Operating Procedure (SOP). Total Army berets are excluded from exhibition wear.



## ACU Arc Tabs

Per CCR 145-2 "The JROTC shoulder sleeve insignia": "How worn. On right sleeve in the corresponding position to the shoulder sleeve of the Army coat and ACU. The top of the insignia will be worn 1/2 inch below the top of the shoulder seam"

Only the subdued JROTC patch is authorized for wear, no arc tabs are authorized on the ACU.

## Shoulder Cords

Per CCR 145-2: "Shoulder cords must be approved by USACC. No more than one cord may be worn on each shoulder."

USACC approved colors are white, red, blue, tan, gold, green, black, orange.
